

# The Power of Teamwork



Nick started at AchieveKids when he was seven. He used to get sent home from school daily for his aggressive behaviors and his inability to interact with other students in a socially appropriate way. He was extremely frustrated and had very low self-esteem. Now he is a mature eighteen-year-old who is very well liked and is a role model for many of our younger students.

AchieveKids has given Nick a safe environment in which to thrive. He now looks forward to going to school where our trained staff focus on his strengths. "AchieveKids provides a structure and

consistency that Nick desperately needed. The partnership between staff and therapists and family is huge. For the first time Nick was finding his ground," said his mother Alicia.

Throughout his time at AchieveKids Nick has worked with a behaviorist, a speech therapist and an occupational therapist and has learned how to communicate his wants and needs to others. He is able to joke with students and staff and is very helpful in the classroom. He continues to make progress academically, improving his reading fluency and comprehension and learning new vocabulary.

Nick is very friendly and empathetic and enjoys sharing his strategies to help peers deal with behavioral challenges. He is really interested in movies and knows all the details of his favorites and loves sharing them with anyone who will listen. He loves music and musicals and singing and dancing to his favorites. His heroes include Mr. Rogers, Martin Luther King Jr. and Dolly Parton.

As part of our Student Career Pathways Program Nick is currently working in our new Palo Alto Library twice a week shelving and returning books and tidying up before the next class comes in.

"AchieveKids has the resources to teach Nick in a very special way. He wouldn't be where he is today without this school. We feel the love and feel part of a school and a community which is so very important," said his mom. Nick is just one example of how the students at AchieveKids benefit from **The Power of Teamwork**.

We are so proud of Nick's journey here and how far he has come and look forward to his future with confidence.



# **Programs**

#### **Special Education**

We offer a range of educational programs from graded core-curriculum to life skills and other functionally-based academics.





## **Community Integration**

We teach students to interact in community environments, from following safety signs, taking public transit and buying groceries, to eating in restaurants.

## **Speech Therapy**

We focus on improving communication skills through one-on-one, in the classroom, on the job, and in the community training.





#### **Behavioral Health**

We focus on replacing aggressive behaviors with appropriate social skills while increasing self-awareness and self-esteem. We conduct student assessments, develop and implement behavior intervention plans and do comprehensive data collection in all our school programs.

### **Student Career Pathway**

We teach both job skills and work-related social skills to students ages 14 and above. We partner with employers in the community to match students 16 and older with jobs that reflect individual interests.





## **Transition Services**

We offer a range of educational programs from graded core-curriculum to life skills and other functionally-based academics.


